## Physical Therapist Assistant

### PTA Program Admission:

Students seeking admission to the Physical Therapist Assistant (PTA) Program must be fully admitted to the college for Spring Semester 2018. To take pre-admission courses, students should enroll in the college's *Healthcare Science Certificate or Interdisciplinary Studies-Health Track*.

The PTA program has a competitive admission process. The selection criteria consist of Admission Points with a total value of **330 points**. See the PTA Admission Points Criteria sheet for additional information.

All students must have a CTC GPA of 2.0 or higher to be considered for program admission. If a student has all transfer credit, and does not have a CTC GPA, this requirement does not apply.

### Transfer Students / Transfer Credit:

If you are a transfer student, you must be fully admitted to Chattahoochee Technical College by Spring Semester 2018, this is to guarantee that all transfer credits will be evaluated and to consider you for program admission. The College's document deadline for Spring Semester 2018 is **Friday, December 8, 2017**.

If you are transferring college credit into Chattahoochee Technical College, official transcripts must be received by the college's document deadline, **Friday, December 8, 2017**.

### ATI TEAS:

Take the ATI TEAS by **Friday, May 4, 2018** and achieve a minimum total adjusted score of 70.00. A student may take the ATI TEAS two (2) times in a calendar year and must wait a minimum of 30 calendar days in between attempts. The ATI TEAS score is valid for five years.

The ATI TEAS is a standardized test that measures the student's ability in math, reading, grammar and science. A study guide and practice test can be purchased at [www.atitesting.com](http://www.atitesting.com). The ATI TEAS is available through the Chattahoochee Technical College's Corporate and Professional Education Department.

### Optional Observation Hours:

All observation hours must be received on or before **Monday, April 30, 2018** by 4pm in order to receive extra points.

Students must document awareness of the job requirements of a physical therapist assistant through volunteer physical therapy observation and/or as a physical therapy aide. Observations must include at least 12 or more hours in an outpatient setting and 12 or more hours in an inpatient setting for a total of 24 hours of observing PT's or PTA's by Monday, April 30, 2018 by 4pm.

Observation must be direct patient observation under the supervision of a PT or PTA. Hours that fulfill this requirement cannot be front office or clerical work.

Detailed instructions for completing hours can be found on the PTA webpage. The observation forms may also be found on the PTA webpage. Students are encouraged to begin their observation hours early. Forms must be received by **4:00pm on Monday, April 30, 2018** to the Health Sciences Office:

**Application Session:**

Applicants must attend an application session during the Spring Semester 2018. Applications are only distributed and accepted during the application session. The schedule will be posted on the PTA webpage during the Spring Semester.

**Final Class Selection:**

Final class selection is based upon the total number of admission points. The students with the highest point value will be accepted into the program.

**CPR:**

Once accepted into the PTA program, students must be certified in CPR for “Healthcare Providers” by the beginning of the Spring Semester 2019.
