Paramedic: Certificate, Diploma, and Degree Spring Semester 2025

Program Location:

Paramedic Program Admission:

Students seeking admission to the paramedic program must be fully admitted to the college for Spring 2025.

Information Session:

All students must attend a virtual information session and complete a program application. Program applications are only given out at the Information Sessions. A schedule of paramedic information sessions will be posted on the paramedic webpage.

Required:

Students must hold a current certification or licensure as an EMT, AEMT, or EMT-I.

Paramedic Certificate Course Work:

The Paramedicine Certificate does not require any additional coursework. All EMSP courses begin in the Spring Semester.

Additional Diploma and Degree Courses:

The following courses are required for those students seeking to obtain either a diploma or a degree. These may be completed at any point. To take any of these courses prior to starting the paramedic program, students should enroll in the college's *Healthcare Assistant Certificate*, *Healthcare Science Certificate* or *Interdisciplinary Studies Degree-Health Track*. Students who do not complete all the diploma or degree level courses by the end of the paramedic program will be awarded a Certificate in Paramedicine. After graduating from the paramedic program, students may continue taking these courses to meet the criteria to receive a degree or diploma in paramedicine.
