Dual Achievement program (DAP) (established by SB 204) offers qualified students an alternate path to high school graduation. Students choose to simultaneously earn a high school diploma and two (2) Technical Certificates of Credit in a specific career pathway. Students must be between the ages of 16 - 21 and have earned 6 high school credits.

Complete all required high school courses:

- 2 English Courses
- 2 Math Courses
- 2 Science Courses
- 2 Social Studies Courses
- 1 Health/PE

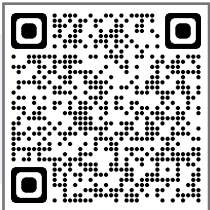
