Information on the Lockheed Production Assembler position offered at Chattahoochee Tech's Aviation Training Academy (ATA)

This is an overview for the Lockheed 10-week Production Assembler position for Lockheed Martin at their Marietta assembly location. You must first apply to the position through the Lockheed Careers website located at the following link <u>Production Assembler - Chattahoochee Tech Training Program | Lockheed Martin</u>. Lockheed has full authority on which people will be admitted to the program. Chatt Tech cannot and does not have any discretion on who is admitted to the program. Once Lockheed accepts you into the program they will direct Chatt Tech to admit you to the program.

- The program is 10 weeks long consisting of 10 ½ hour instructional day and ½ hour lunch starting at 7a and finishing at 530p 4 days a week.
- During the first 5 weeks you will be a student of Chattahoochee Tech ATA.
- If you meet all the competencies during the first 5 weeks and Lockheed deems you employable based upon your skills and grades they will hire you as a Lockheed employee on day 1 of week 6.
- During weeks 6, 7 and 8 you will complete the remainder of your projects and training at ATA while getting paid as a Lockheed employee.
- During week 9 and 10 you will report to the Lockheed Marietta plant to finish out the last two weeks of training. From there you will become a full time Lockheed employee.
